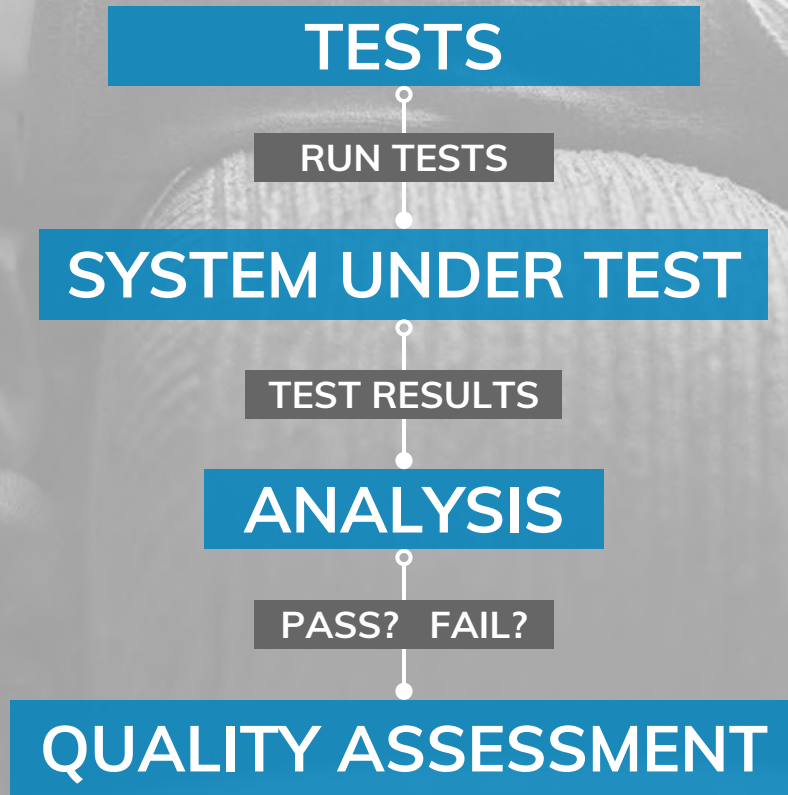

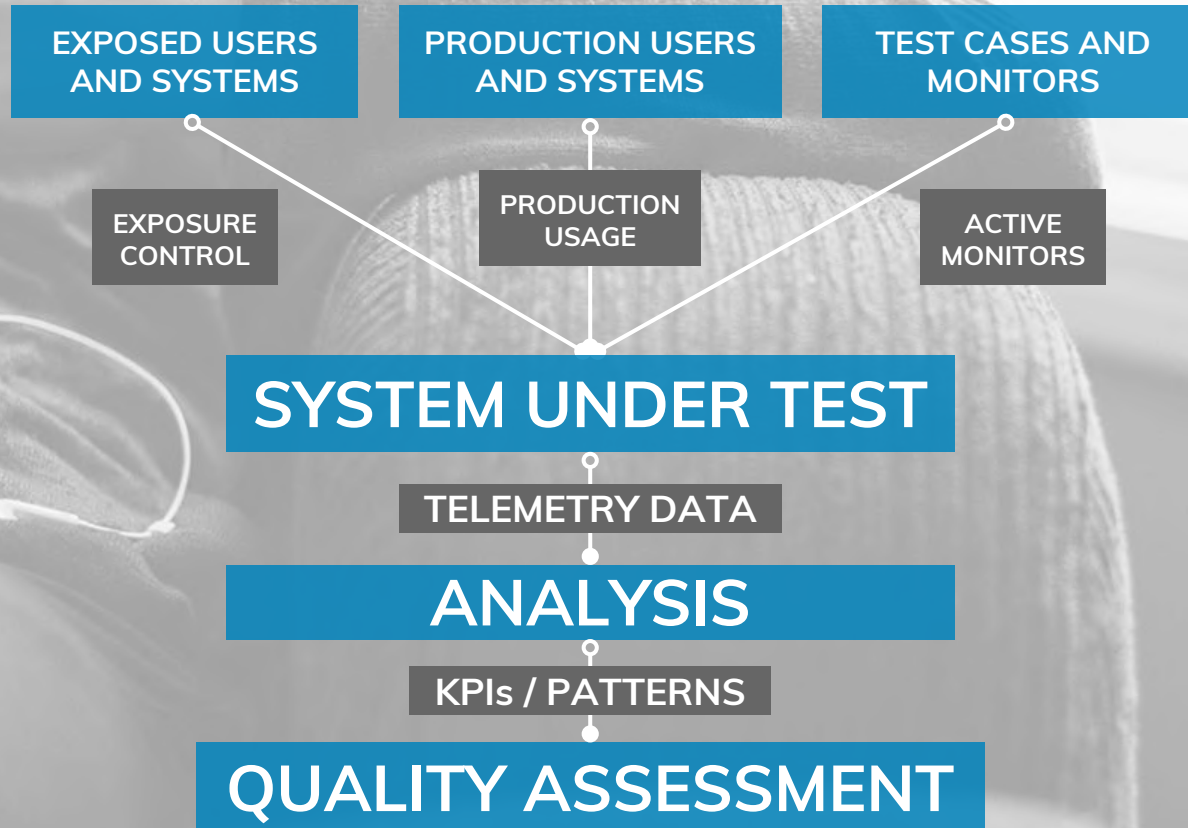

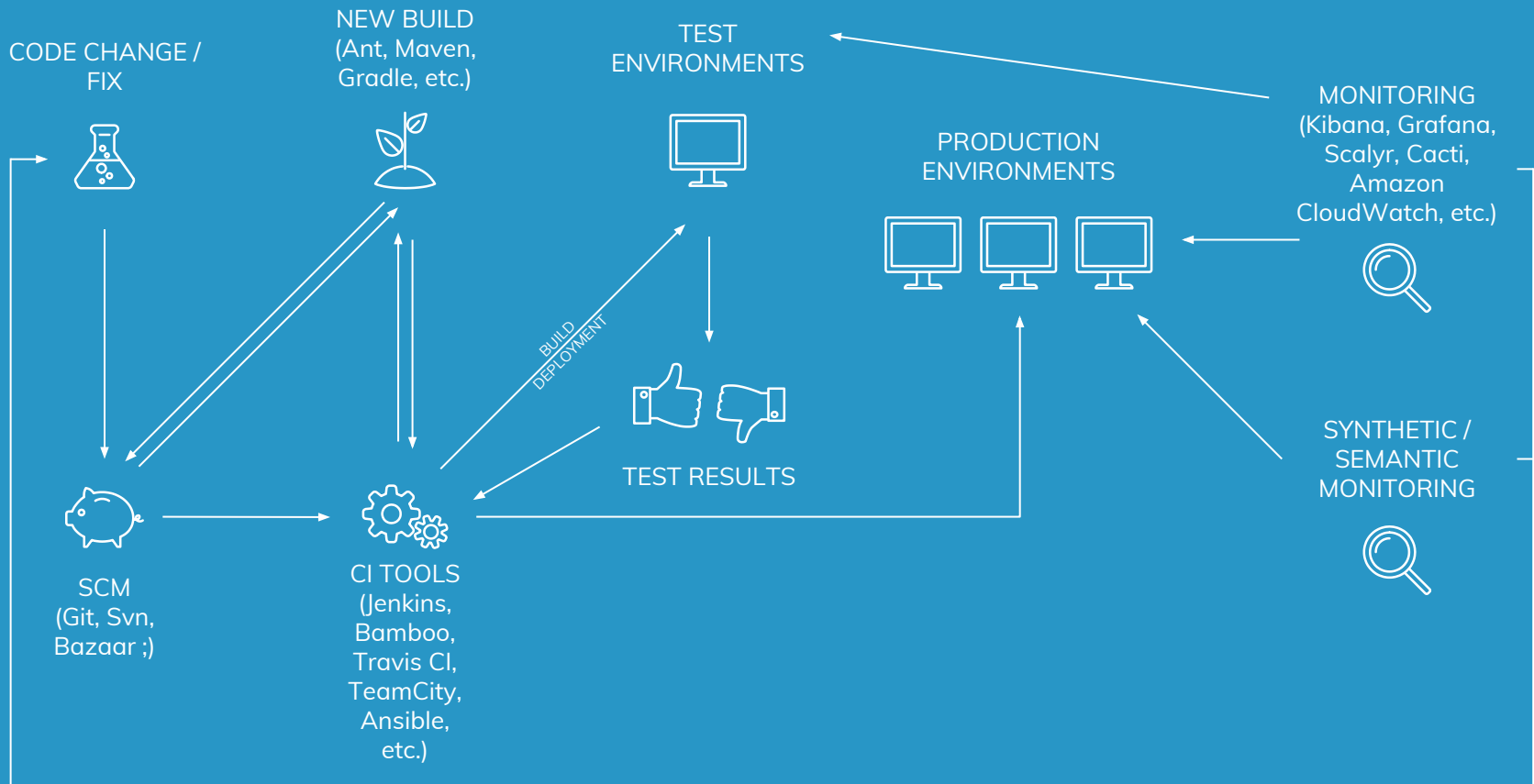

Continuous Monitoring



- Synthetic monitoring (or semantic monitoring) runs a subset of an application's automated tests against the live production system on a regular basis.

2) Pains of “high tech” companies

 - No TDD/BDD/XP, lack of Unit tests
 - No documentation
 - Not enough testers!
- Event-driven development (CES, IoT World, etc.)

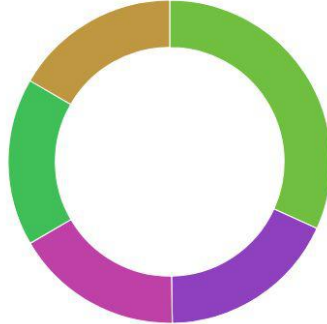

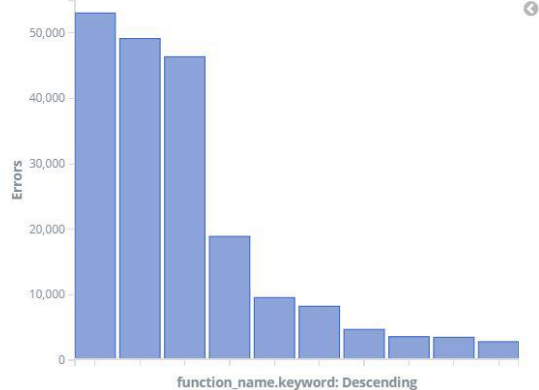
